Dear Resident,

Wishing you a Happy New Year from the Rennerdale Volunteer Fire Department! Since 1944, we've been dedicated to protecting our community. We hope you've had a chance to visit our station, but if not, we hope you can stop by soon. This past year, we responded to over 400 calls, a 15% increase, averaging more than one call a day. Our small team of less than 20 dedicated firefighters and 30 social volunteers ensures that every call is answered, 24/7/365.



To continue providing top-notch service, we rely on your support. Inflation has significantly increased the costs of equipment, training, and facility maintenance. Over 50% of our budget comes from fundraising, while less than 50% is covered by township support. Additionally, our station requires urgent renovations, diverting funds from critical firefighting needs. We're asking for your help to ensure we can keep our community and firefighters safe.



Despite years of advocating for increased funding with our township commissioners, we've faced challenges. Our emergency services fee continues to stay reduced and reallocated to the general fund and police department. Unfortunately, the township plans to further reduce our funding in 2025 for the second year running.

To maintain our commitment to providing 24/7 emergency services, we must heavily rely on community support. Your generous donation will directly impact our ability to purchase essential equipment, train our volunteers, and keep our vehicles operational. We hope you'll join us in ensuring the safety of our community.
